How to Add a Google Chrome Extension		To download a google extension: Click the 3 lines at the top right of your Chrome browser. Choose Extensions. Choose, "Get More Extensions". Search the store for the title of the extension. Add to Chrome.
Grades K-12	Google Extension: Text to Speech	Title of App: <i>Speak It</i> . After downloading, click speaker icon on top right of toolbar within Google Chrome. User may need to highlight speech first. Several languages can be selected by opening the extension's options.
Grades 1-12	Google Extension: On-line Highlighter	Title of App: <i>Super Simple Highlighter</i> . After downloading, highlight text then right click on text. Select Super Simple Highlighter tool then select color.
