

The District has presented a proposed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to Twin Rivers Teachers' Representatives to extend the deadline for the completion of the 1% Certificated Professional Development. We have been notified that the Executive Board for the Twin Rivers Teachers' Representatives declined the MOU. Therefore, the deadline for the 1% Professional Development completion will remain Dec. 1, 2017.

The MOU would have extended the deadline for the completion of the 1% Professional Development from Dec. 1, 2017 to Jan. 31, 2018. This MOU would have given employees more time to complete the Professional Development and would have allowed an expansion of course opportunities.

RE: Extension of 1% Professional Development Completion

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made between:
Twin Rivers United Educators and the Twin Rivers Unified School District.

The purpose is to modify the current Professional Development 1% completion date.

1. For the 2017-2018 school year the Agreement dated July 29, 2017 and Board Approved on August 2, 2017 states:

One-time 1% off Salary Schedule for Professional Development outside of the regular work day paid from Supplemental Concentration Funding for twelve (12) hours of professional development as determined by the District. Attendance is voluntary; however, attendance is required for payment, no pro-ration and completion by December 1, 2017.

2. Modified language:
One-time 1% off Salary Schedule for Professional Development outside of the regular work day paid from Supplemental Concentration Funding for twelve (12) hours of professional development as determined by the District. Attendance is voluntary; however, attendance is required for payment, no pro-ration and completion by January 31, 2018.
3. This agreement shall be in effect for the 2017-2018 academic calendar year.
4. By signing this Memorandum of Understanding the parties agree to be bound by the obligations and expectations set forth herein.
