Measure B Passes

Measure B, the ballot measure to consolidate four school districts in northern Sacramento County, passed in Tuesday's election with a 60 percent voter approval. The vote will consolidate Rio Linda Union, Grant Joint Union High School, North Sacramento, and Del Paso Heights School Districts into a new unified preschool through 12th grade school district.

The new district will take effect on July 1, 2008 and will serve more than 30,000 students.
