## **Twin Rivers Bond Oversight Committee Seeks Members**

Twin Rivers USD is looking for seven volunteers to serve on its Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee. The committee is responsible for reviewing expenditures of bond money approved by voters.

Volunteers must be at least 18 years old and reside in school district boundaries. The deadline for applying is Feb. 28, 2013. Applications are available at the district's Facilities Department (3222 Winona Way, North Highlands, CA 95660), the district website at [www.twinriversusd.org](http://www.twinriversusd.org), or by calling 566-1600, Ext. 55571.

The committee, which will be appointed by the Board of Trustees, must include:

- A parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the district.
- A member active in a business organization, representing the business community within the district.
- A member active in a senior citizen's organization.
- A member active in a bona fide taxpayers association.
- A member who is both a parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the district and active in a parent-teacher organization such as the PTA or school site council.
- Two members of the community at-large.

District employees and any vendor, contractor or consultant doing business with the district are not eligible to apply.
