## **Two Twin Rivers Schools Receive Title I Academic Achievement Awards**

SACRAMENTO — Two TRUSD schools have been named as 2009-2010 Title I Academic Achievement Award winners.

Linda Bean, Principal from **Hazel Strauch** Elementary and Linda Kyle, Principal from **Oakdale** Elementary, received a personal telephone call from State Superintendent of Public Instruction Jack O'Connell, conveying the good news and congratulating the schools on their hard work.

The schools were selected because they demonstrated that all students are making significant progress toward proficiency on California's academic content standards. Additionally, the school's socio-economically disadvantaged students doubled the achievement targets set for them for two consecutive years.

“This award provides important recognition to schools that are swimming upstream and making significant gains in exceeding state academic standards for students,” said Twin Rivers Superintendent Frank Porter. “The award recognizes hard work and high expectations required of administrators, teachers, staff, students, and parents.”

Title I is the single largest federal educational program for K-12 public education. Title 1 funds assist schools in meeting the educational needs of students living near or at the poverty level.
