Foothill High School was selected for this project because of its goal of developing the "whole student" by directing their focus on academics, athletics, and building of individual character.

The field overhaul (including batting-cage renovation, dugout maintenance, windscreen installation, painting and gardening) will begin, rain or shine, at 8 a.m.
