The two speakers will share their experiences working with Cesar Chavez and talk to students about his legacy of service.

Anthony Chavez was raised in the farm worker movement his grandfather founded. He grew up participating in United Farm Workers' marches, picket lines and political campaigns. The oldest son of Socorro and Paul Chavez, Cesar Chavez's middle son, Anthony speaks around the country before numerous student and community groups on behalf of the Cesar Chavez Foundation, established to further his grandfather's life and work. He is also working on service learning and character education initiatives with the Alameda County Office of Education.

Marc Grossman was Cesar Chavez's longtime press secretary, speechwriter and personal aide and directed international media coverage of his April 1993 funeral in Delano, Calif. He still serves as a spokesman for the United Farm Workers of America and is communications director for the Cesar Chavez Foundation.
