SACRAMENTO—For the first time since last May, students will be able to run freely on the grassy fields of Smythe Academy on Northgate Boulevard. Thanks to a half million dollar grant from the City of Sacramento, the renovations include new drainage, upgraded irrigation, new grass, five softball fields, and concrete walkways to the snack bar.

Following an opening ceremony, every class will take their first run across the field. In addition to PE classes, recess and after school programs, the grassy fields at Smythe Academy are also used by the Twin Rivers Soccer League and Natomas Girls Softball League.
