Twin Rivers Launches Aggressive Plan for HVAC Installation

(SACRAMENTO) — Twin Rivers Unified School District will hold a news conference at 10 a.m. Wednesday, April 2, to announce an aggressive plan for installing heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) units in two schools—Grant Union High School and Harmon Johnson Elementary. The district has been criticized recently for delays in getting the HVAC units operational.

This new five-month effort is being launched as a campaign called “Feel the Difference: Creating a new climate in our classrooms.” It is coordinated by a District task force comprised of principals from Grant Union and Harmon Johnson, along with representatives from facilities, maintenance, contracts, business, and communications.

Task force members will describe the details and timeline for installing the 71 HVAC units. Visuals will include blueprints, timelines, and an actual HVAC unit that is slated for installation.

“We understand the community’s frustration in the past with delays in getting this important project off the ground,” said TRUSD Superintendent Dr. Steven Martinez, who chairs the task force. “We now have the administrative team working in close collaboration so that every phase of this installation will hit its marks and stay on schedule. When schools reopen at the end of summer break, our students, staff and parents will be able to feel the difference.”
