One Ocean, One Planet

Sacramento School Benefits from Highly-Acclaimed Mobile Education Tour

To celebrate Environmental Education Week, the Wyland Foundation, Disney Nature's OCEANS, and Volvo Cars of North America are bringing the "One Ocean, One Planet" mobile education tour to students at North Avenue Elementary School in Del Paso Heights on Friday, April 9.

Students will be given tours of the 1,000 square foot biodiesel powered mobile theater and science center, where they will learn more about the relationship of inland and coastal communities to the ocean. Students will also have the opportunity to paint a collaborative ocean-themed mural featuring coral reefs with tips and guidance from local artists.

The mission of the \$750,000 mobile exhibit is to educate students about the protection of watersheds, marine life conservation, and the relationship of art, photography and film in documenting changes in oceanic ecosystems.
