Opening of Bids

SACRAMENTO—It's a big day in Twin Rivers as bids will be opened for a massive heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) project scheduled for summer. The district will spend \$7.6 million on the HVAC projects at Grant Union High School and Harmon Johnson Elementary School.

Staff will review the bids and confirm the low bidder has complied with all requirements before submitting a recommendation to the Board of Trustees on April 23. By California state law, the successful bidder will be given 10 days to submit insurance and other requirements.

The HVAC projects are slated for completion by August 11, just in time for the new school year to begin. This five-month effort is being launched as a campaign called "Feel the Difference: Creating a New Climate in Our Classrooms."
