### Background

The refurbished centralized office is funded through facility bonds (Measure G) approved by voters for the construction of a new district office. The funds must be used for the facility projects listed in the bond language. The funds cannot be used for personnel or ongoing operational costs. The buildings formerly used by the unifying districts will be put to good use for other programs and/or educational purposes. For example, the RLUSD office will provide additional space for full-day kindergarten, the DPHSD office is now a classroom, the GJUHS office will allow the Twin Rivers Police Department and Adult Education Program additional space and possibly allow for community college access. The NSSD office will allow our Student Services staff to have a presence in one of our most at-risk neighborhoods.

### Cost

Although \$20 million was marked for the district office project in the bond, the refurbished offices at 5115 Dudley have cost just over \$14 million—a savings of almost \$6 million over building a new facility. The remaining \$6 million will be used to address the East Natomas Education Complex (proposed JHS/HS in Natomas).

### Conference Room Availability

There are a variety of conference rooms available at 5115 Dudley. These larger meeting rooms will reduce the need for renting outside space for district-wide meetings and events, and can generate revenue when rented to outside agencies.

### Proposed Water Feature

There are plans for a water feature design contest with secondary students this fall. Materials will be contributed by business partners and students will build the feature next year. While the cost will be minimal, the new water feature will give students valuable experience and serve as a constant reminder of the creativity and skills of Twin Rivers students and staff.
