Opportunity of a Lifetime for Grant Union High School Drumline

SACRAMENTO—The award-winning Grant Union High School Drumline has been selected to represent California in the 2015 National Independence Day Parade in Washington D.C. Only a handful of high schools across the country are selected annually for this honor.

Drumline Director James Van Buren is ecstatic.

“This is huge—an incredible opportunity for our young people,” says Van Buren. “I am just blown away. While I love the fact that we are in this position, there is a lot of pressure, too. Right now, I have 15 drummers, 10 Pacerettes (dancers) and 10 chaperones making the trip. We need to raise approximately \$100,000.”
