Stella's Coming ... to Rio Linda Prep

McClellan, CA— The world's first solar-powered family car that produces more energy than it uses will make a key stop in Twin Rivers USD on Thursday, Sept. 18. Stella will travel from the State Capitol to Rio Linda Preparatory Academy, the only middle school in the country the vehicle and its design team will visit as part of National Drive Electric Week.

Designed by students at Eindhoven University of Technology in the Netherlands, Stella can drive almost 500 miles on a single charge, seats four and has a top speed of 75 mph.

"We're very excited because this visit directly aligns with our sixth grade science content standards and our newly adopted Common Core State Standards," says Principal Maria Sevilla. "This is a great opportunity for our Project Lead the Way (pre-engineering program) and Mathematics, Engineering and Science Achievement (MESA) students to talk to the Stella team and learn about the importance of utilizing alternative energy sources."

National Drive Electric Week is a free coast-to-coast observance designed to showcase the fun, convenience, and clean-air benefits of electric vehicles.
