**TR School Buses Pass Rigorous Inspection**

McClellan, CA— Twin Rivers' school bus fleet received a satisfactory rating on the California Highway Patrol's (CHP) most recent terminal inspection. It's the highest rating for school bus terminals. TR buses are inspected each day before going into service by drivers and annually by the CHP, as required by law.

"It's all about student safety," says Tim Shannon, TR's Director of Transportation. "Our top priority is to safely transport students to and from school so it's crucial our buses are in top operating condition. I'm proud of the entire transportation team. We have worked hard to achieve this rating by building a very productive and efficient shop to meet the high standards of the school bus transportation industry."

Twin Rivers has 95 buses and 89 drivers. All drivers go through special training and are certified by the CHP.
