Community Budget Forums

Parents, employees and community members will get a clearer picture of the financial challenges facing Twin Rivers Unified School District during a series of budget forums hosted by the district.

The first one coincides with a meeting of the TRUSD Budget Advisory Committee at 6 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 24, 2012, at the district office, 5115 Dudley Boulevard, McClellan Park.

“We are facing extraordinary budget challenges and there are no easy answers,” says Rob Ball, Associate Superintendent for Business Support Services. “We’re holding these forums because we want to keep the community informed. We also want our parents, students, teachers and support staff to know that our commitment to providing the best education possible to all students will not waver in these tough economic times.”

The forum will feature presentations from Ball and Executive Director of Fiscal Services Kate Ingersoll. They will discuss current budget projections, cuts made since budget adoption, and proposals for additional cuts totaling approximately \$5 million for the current year.

In addition, Ball will discuss the devastating impact on education if Proposition 30 or Proposition 38 fails to pass in the Nov. 6 elections. The failure of Proposition 30 could result in the shortening of this school year by up to 15 additional days.
