**Grant Union High School Promenade Ribbon Cutting Ceremony**

A student parade with the Grant Union High School Drumline and the unveiling of a new 24-foot Pacer logo are just a few of the festivities scheduled for a Dec. 6, 2013, ribbon cutting ceremony for the school's new Pacer Promenade.

The promenade was completed this summer and culminated with more than 100 volunteers planting hundreds of plants and trees—transforming an asphalt roadway into a safe, shaded walkway.

Students from Grant's GEO Environmental Science and Design Academy worked with UC Davis Landscape Architecture students to design the promenade and a master plan for their school several years ago. In 2012, the Sacramento Tree Foundation was awarded a \$990,000 Strategic Growth Council Urban Greening Grant to implement the first phase of the master plan.
