Former World Champion Track Star at Grant

McClellan, CA—Marion Jones has a message for young people and she's bringing it to Grant Union High School. The former Olympic champion, stripped of her 2000 Summer Olympic medals after admitting to steroid use, will talk with student athletes on Jan. 12 about *Take a Break*—a program Jones created that encourages young people to stop, step away and think when they are faced with a difficult decision.
