Canadian Education Researchers Continue Twin Rivers Case Study

McClellan, CA— Three distinguished researchers from the Ontario Institute for Studies in Education at the University of Toronto are visiting Twin Rivers Unified School District and will observe two classrooms on May 4, 2016.

Dr. Santiago Ricon-Gallardo, Dr. Nancy Watson and Dr. Joelle Rodway are part of a team headed by renowned Canadian author and education expert Michael Fullan who is conducting a case study of Twin Rivers and three other California school districts.
